The winner of the
2009 IRMCO Team Award is the:

Multimodal Hazardous Materials
Intelligence Portal Team at the
Department of Transportation



Their accomplishments include:

- o Establishing a Multimodal Hazardous Materials Intelligence (HIP) portal that enhances the effectiveness and efficiency of the national hazardous materials transportation safety and security programs.
- o Innovatively coordinating an enterprise business intelligence tool that allows for vital communication sharing of information between six agencies that their line of business is to protect life, property, and the environment from the dangers inherent to the transportation of hazardous materials.
- o Integrating the agencies information to provide DOT easy access to crucial information, needed to make strategic and operational decisions.



As a result of the implementation of the new HIP collaboration tool the following benefits were immediately realized:

- Multi-agency collaboration and transparency of data and information;
- Decisions based on unified enterprise information rather than on fragmented information;
- Identification of high risk shippers and carriers;
- Maximizing the value of limited resources;
- Reducing the number of serious incidents;
- Identifying training and outreach opportunities;
- Building alliances and partnerships with other Federal, state, and local agencies;
- Providing a one-stop shop for HAZMAT data.



What's the bottom line? DOT expects:

To reduce the number of compliance reviews with the use of the HIP tool, by 66 inspections which equates to at least \$24,000/year.

To reduce the time that inspectors spend (over 1,340 hours) trying to locate shippers/carriers, which equates to over \$1 million/year in cost avoidance.

The team proved itself to be a true steward of American citizens' tax dollars implementing the HIP tool which also supports transparency by providing this one-stop access to HAZMAT data and information, to stakeholders, customers, and interested stakeholders. This translates to better government and reduced costs to the American people.



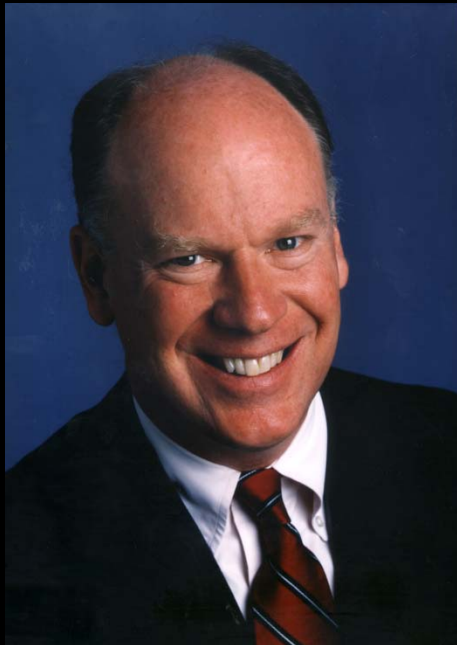
